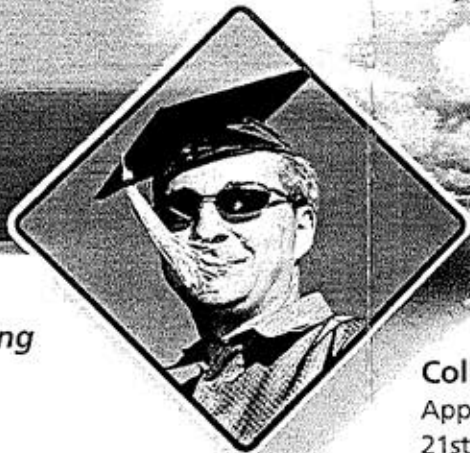


What is NJ PLACE?

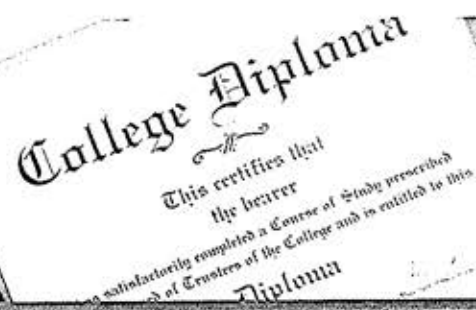
Whether you want to upgrade your skills to become a foreman, manager, or superintendent at a construction site, or open your own business, **NJ PLACE** can help!

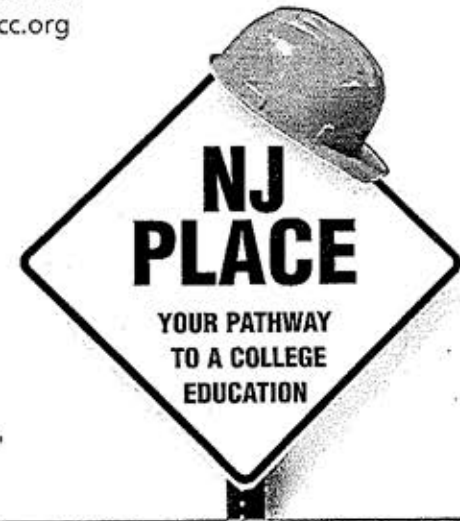

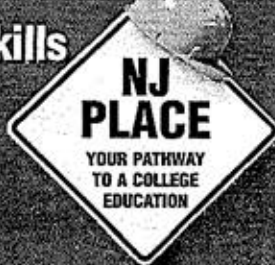

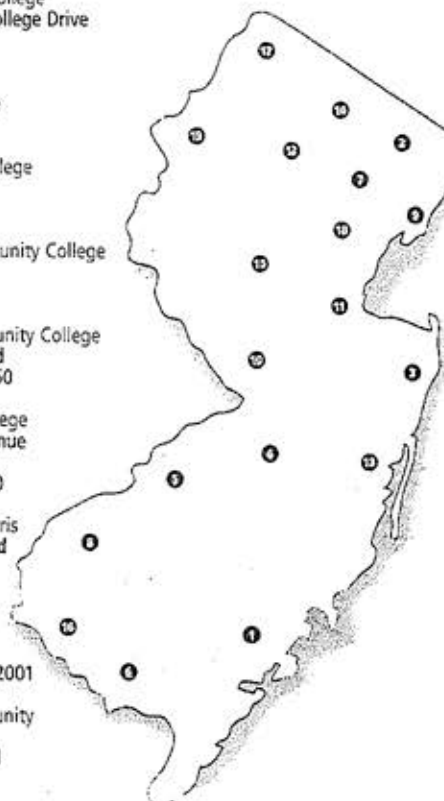
